There were many people at the train station,” shared Larysa. The family found shelter in a refugee centre supported by the ACT Alliance. “We are happy to have a place to sleep and where it is warm. It is safe here. I am glad our children are alive.” Presbyterian World Service & Development is supporting Hungarian Interchurch Aid with an appeal issued by the ACT Alliance to provide emergency food assistance, essential non-food aid, health care and emotional support to refugees and internally displaced people.*
